4. ***A Guide to the Fortifications and Battlefields around Petersburg - A Guide to the Fortifications and Battlefields around Petersburg*** was originally published in 1866 by the proprietors of Jarratt's Hotel. This is the first book ever written about preserving and interpreting the Civil War resources around the city of Petersburg. The book suggests key sites for guests to visit and also provides an account of why the sites are significant. Within the book is a map of the entrenched lines in the immediate front of Petersburg, as well as numerous advertisements for local businesses and merchants. This book is reproduced from an original and retains the advertisements, layout and feel of the period.

Upon completion of each activity in the book, children receive one of three patches that feature an image of a bear effigy. The initial interments, beginning in February 1864, were of those who died in the nearby prisoner of war camp. Today the cemetery contains more than 18,000 interments. *Andersonville National Cemetery: Resting Place of Honor*, provides information on how the cemetery is arranged, the significance of various headstone markings, and a general history of how and why the cemetery was created.
